The Tall Ship is immediately adjacent to the Museum of Transport and conveniently situated for access to both central Glasgow for shopping, sightseeing and nightlife and also the lively West End which has many cafes and bars and things to see and do such as Kelvingrove Museum.

A pleasant walk along the waterfront takes you to the City Centre or there is a Waterbus service and the City Sightseeing Tour buses call at the Museum of Transport. The nearby Partick railway station is served by frequent trains from every part of the City and further afield and also has a bus interchange.

Glasgow is well supplied with hotels of every standard.
