

# Event Notes - Fergus Estuary Raid 21

## Programme

Fri 9th HW 4.55 @ 06:42 and 4.78 @ 1857

Launch at Kildysert, or Crovraghan. Crovraghan should not be used for parking beyond 3pm on Sunday due to Cannon Island pilgrimage at 18:00 Sunday. There is an option to park campervans at Crovraghan on the Friday night and transfer them early on Saturday.

Visit Paradise Quay -  
Sail to Crovraghan

Saturday 10th HW 4.65 @ 07:21 and 4.89 @ 19:33  
To Coney Is for exploration of houses and monuments  
To Cannon Island Monastery  
Sail to Inishloe overnight camp.

Sunday 11th HW 4.71 m @ 07:59 and 4.96m @ 20:11  
Explore Inishloe  
Option - Canon Is to join the Pilgrimage and overnight in Kildysert  
Option - Kildysert to overnight or to haul out

Monday  
Option- Haul out Kildysert  
Option - Further exploration.

## Navigation

The slip at Kildysert is usable three hours away from high water. It is a bit steep. The channel from Kildysert harbour is marked with perches.  
Crovraghan is a new pier and slip, information is that it is usable at any stage of tide.  
Tides are spring tides so boats are expected to dry out in mud. Currents can be strong out in the estuary. The attached chart image shows primary landing places (LP). The north shore of Inishloe is a mudbank - the south shore has a sandy beach and the southeast has reasonable firm ground. Depending on the wind we will choose our spot to land and to anchor.

## Other

Cattle on the islands may not see many humans, keep clear.  
We need to give space to the local population on Sunday afternoon. We have been told we will be OK to join the pilgrimage but not to take up parking space.
