11:00 To Irelands Eye beach for swim & Picnic

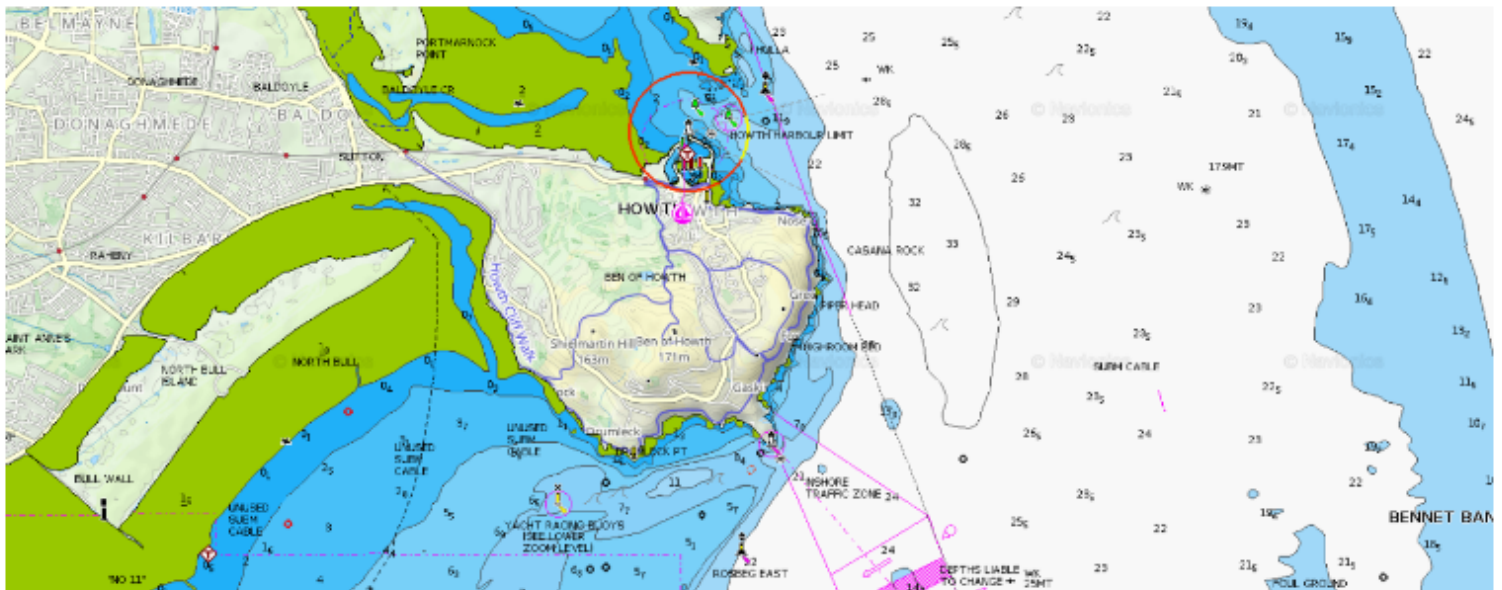
15:00 Race or Sail around Irelands Eye with the Old Gaffers fleet.
